RESOLUTION NO. _____

**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE NAMING OF A 6-MILE LONG
TRIBUTARY IN WYANDOTTE COUNTY AFTER CHIEF NE CON HE CON**

WHEREAS, Ne con He con (1809-1863) served honorably ten years as the elected Chief of the Wolf Band of the Delaware Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Chief Ne con He con and his fellow chiefs resisted railroad and timber companies, land speculators, and other efforts to appropriate tribal land; and

WHEREAS, Chief Ne con He con was not legally able to sign his own name on treaties, requiring the signature of a white witness; and

WHEREAS, after losing their land in territorial Kansas, Chief Ne con He con led initial efforts of the Delaware to resettle in Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, all this occurred during escalatory violent confrontations over the expansion of slavery into Kansas; and

WHEREAS, Chief Ne con He con sought to convince other Native American tribes to align with the Union during the civil war; and

WHEREAS, he is buried near the headwaters of a creek in Wyandotte County. His tombstone reads “He was a true friend to his people and to the U.S. Government. An honest upright man”; and

WHEREAS, this creek is a currently unnamed 6-mile-long unnamed tributary of Wolf Creek; and

WHEREAS, this creek was historically referred to in 19th century documents as Ne con He con Creek; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Board on Geographic Names (BGN) has received a proposal from the Vice President of the Bonner Springs Historic Preservation Society to make official the historical name Ne con He con Creek; and

WHEREAS, the BGN has asked for input from the Unified Government.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE
UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:**

1. The Unified Government fully supports the BGN proposal to make official the historical name Ne Con He con Creek for the 6-mile long tributary shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto.
2. The Mayor, the County Administrator, and the Unified Government's other officers, agents, and employees are hereby authorized and directed to take such further action, and execute such other documents, certificates, and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Resolution.
3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage by the Unified Government Board of Commissioners.

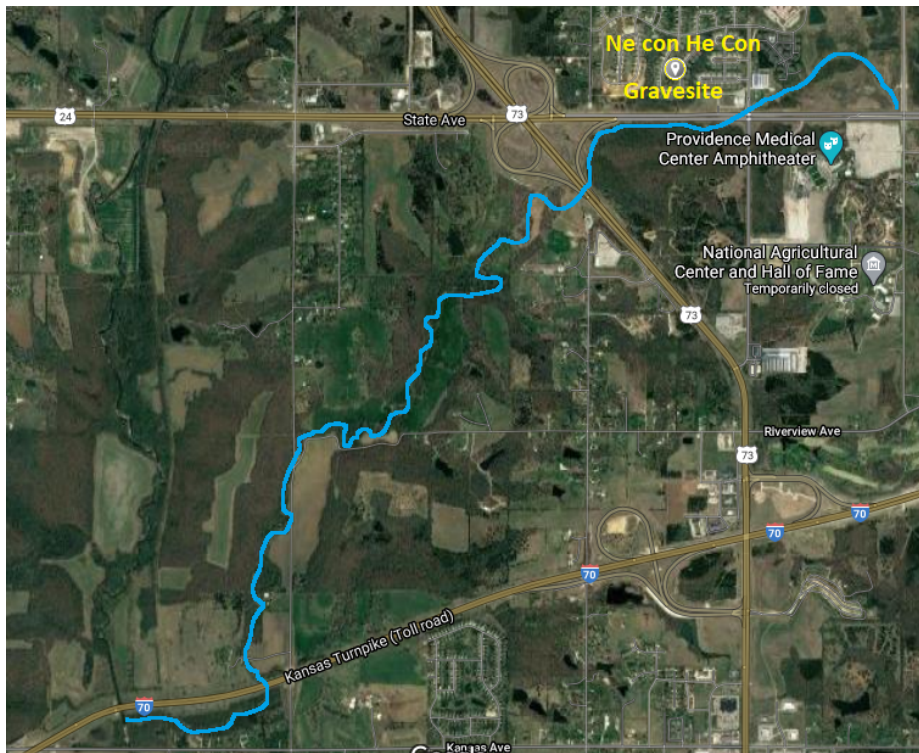
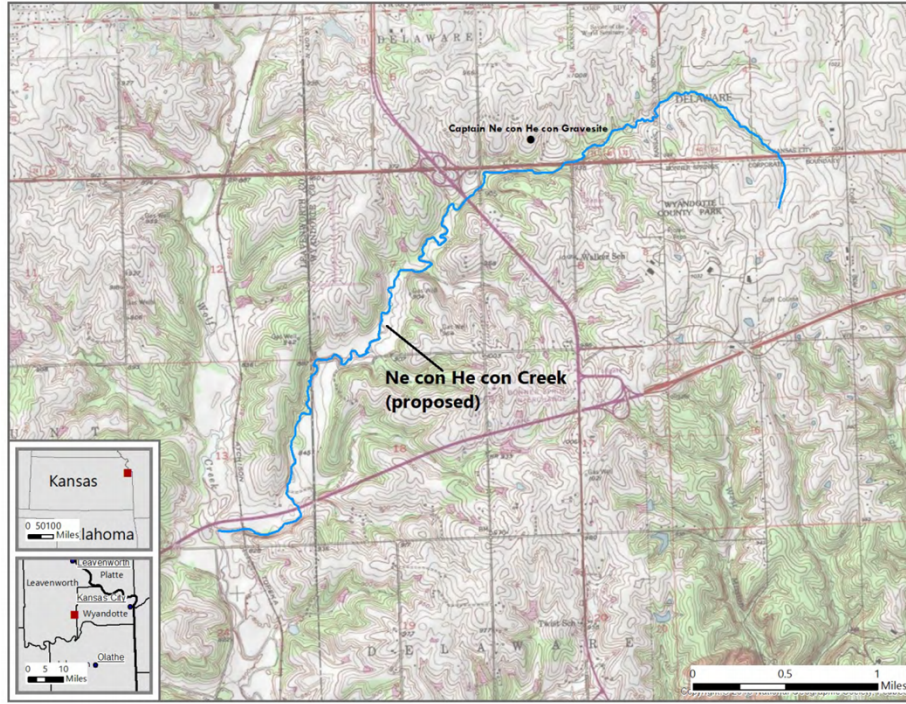
