Item Description:

Grant application to KDHE in the amount of \$923,365.00 KDHE ELC COVID-19 Infrastructure Expansion. This grant funding is intended to provide critical resources in a broad range of COVID-19 testing and epidemiologic surveillance related activities. These awards will support testing, contract tracing, surveillance, containment, and mitigation to monitor and suppress the spread of COVID-19. Awards are based on county population but also include a base amount of \$100,000 for each health department. No match required.

The UGPHD first learned about this funding opportunity on 2/22 from KDHE, and submitted the application 3/15. Because the funding is an allocation of federal funds, we are confident in the award. We do not know when KDHE will notify us of the final funding award, or make the funds available. The funds will pay for COVID-related testing, surveillance, and vaccination support; costs that would otherwise come from UG/local sources. UG Commission approval of the funding, will allow us to utilize the funding source when it becomes available to us, should KDHE move quickly. This will save UGPHD and Budget the considerable labor of using General Fund expenses now for COVID grant-funded projects, and having to reimburse those costs later on to the General Fund through the grant. Therefore UGPHD requests this item be fast-tracked to the Administration Human & Services Standing Committee on 3/22. And pending approval from that Standing Committee, UGPHD also requests the item then be fast-tracked to the Full Commission for final approval on 3/25. Thank you for your consideration, and for the extra work of those involved to expedite this action.

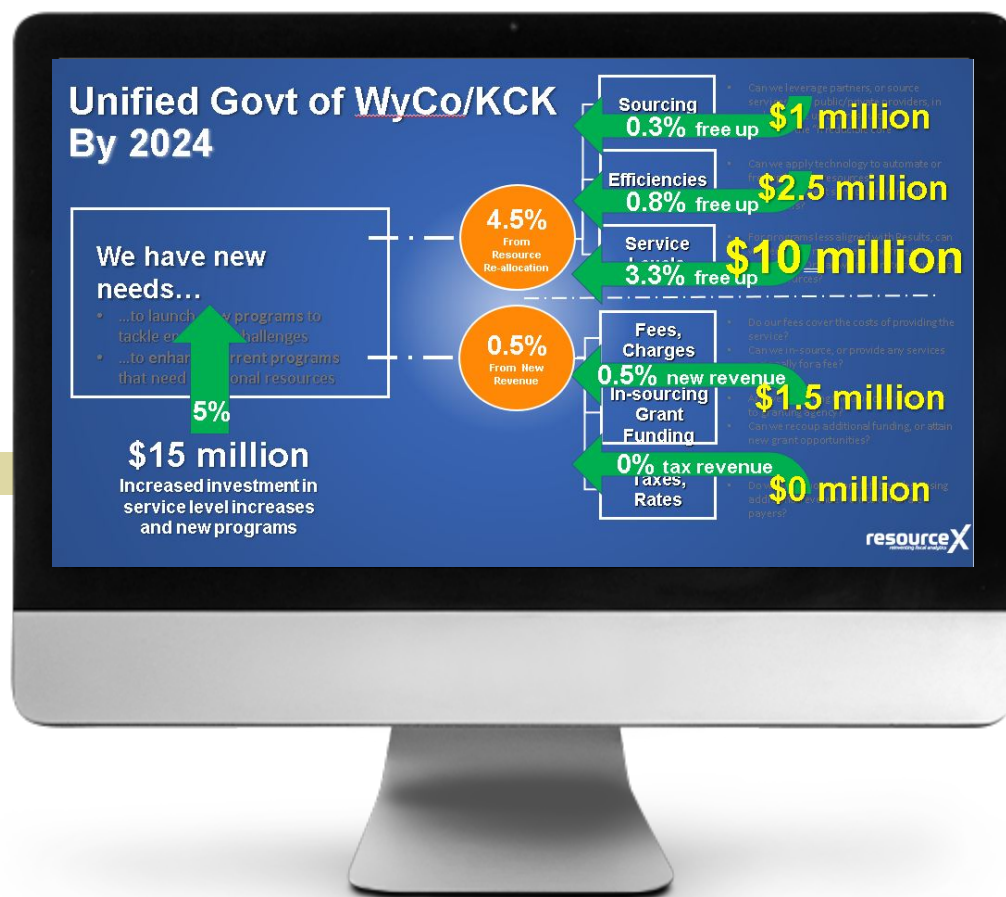

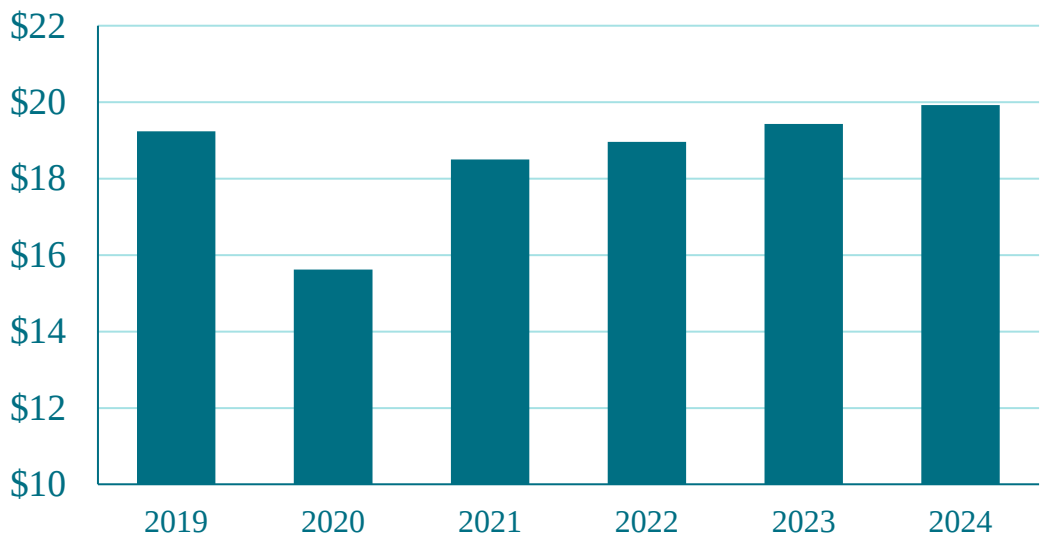
