• The FY24 All Hands on DECK grant program requires no match from the Unified Government. • All items will be funded at 100% through the grant. 1. The Police Department will be requesting funding to support and expand youth programming at the Police Athletic League of Kansas City, KS (PAL). ▪ Contractual services for additional athletic coaches and program instructors at the PAL ▪ Overtime costs for patrol officers assisting with the PAL's driver's education program ▪ Supplies to support additional PAL programming for DECK youth ▪ Care bags to provide to drug-endangered children 2. Additionally, funds will be used to advertise a fentanyl awareness/education video on social media platforms 3. Lastly, funds will be requested to send KCKPD personnel to required DEC trainings. ▪ Attendees of these trainings will train officers during annual Advanced Officer Training (AOT) and Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) trainings		
IT/POLICY CONSIDERATIONS		
The Child In Need of Care (CINC) general order and the Narcotics Unit Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) would need to be amended to include language regarding the DEC response/activation protocol.		
PROCUREMENT CONSIDERATIONS		

- All of the supply items that the Police Department plans to purchase will be less than the \$5k purchase order threshold. As such, we will obtain quotes and select the vendor with the most economical pricing in compliance with the UG's Procurement Policy.
- Contractual services will be in keeping with the MOU already established with the PAL

LEGAL CONSIDERATIONS

- If awarded funding under this grant opportunity, we will be required to sign an award document that outlines assurances we must comply with before we are able to expend any grant funding.
 1. Those assurances will be distributed to agencies selected to receive an award and are, therefore, unavailable to us at this time.
 2. If there are any assurances we are unable to comply with, we have the option to decline acceptance of the award.

Complaint Letter to Unified Government filed 04/2024

Animal Control problem

Within approximately five(5) years several incidents have occurred at my home and within my block and neighborhood.

1. Dogs, with two and four-legs, in the community according to me and some of my neighbors have created havoc.

The four-legs are usually unrestrained and unleashed, chase bicycle riders, bite people, drop their manure in yards, turn over cans and frighten ***school children***.

- A. Approximately 2 years ago I called animal control regarding unleashed dogs chasing me in my yard, dropping manure in my yard, chasing me when I ride my bicycle; when I asked about defending myself; She an animal control person said it is against the law to fire a weapon within the city; she also mimicked her love for her personal dog.

- B. My neighbors stated that they observed dangerous dogs unleashed, that had bitten individuals; It is stinking and disgusting when removing dog dung from a yard.

- C. Several months ago a person was walking past the homes of neighbors complaining about being bitten by a dog.

- D. Several months ago, I discovered a deceased large dog in a large box in my backyard, thereafter I called animal control, of which I have done before when demised animals are seen on the streets.

- E. 03/26/24 animal control placed a notice on my glass screen which stated " come pick up Your brown and white pitbull"; I attached to the notice stating that "I did not have a dog, please remove this notice", unfortunate after calling an authority emphasizing that I did not own a dog; ***animal control did not remove the notice, thereafter someone removed my statement; thereafter I put another statement at the bottom of animal control notice, stating that " I have never owned a dog".*** As of 04/15/24 the notice from animal control is still on my front door.

The perpetrator and ***false information/harassment*** must be ***identified***, located and prosecuted to the fullest of the law before the wrong house is falsely submitted again by another perpetrator.

P.s. Hopefully this problem will be resolved without me initiating an attorney.
